TO: Prospective U.S. or International Applicants

Welcome, in the precious name of Jesus! Enclosed are the necessary applications and documents needed to start your process in participating in our Global Leadership Training Center (GLTC), a time of intensive hands-on missions' training and experience. The GLTC program is based in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. Please make sure **you have read, completed and signed every part of the application.** We will not be able to process your application or accept you into the program until we receive **ALL** required forms and documents including recommendations.

We **strongly recommend** that you consult *immediately* the U.S. Embassy or its website. If you are an international applicant, when applying for your visa, request a tourist or visitor's visa. Requests for visa interviews may need to be submitted up to three (3) months ahead of time. Then, complete and submit your application. After your application is processed and reviewed, you will receive notification of your acceptance status and/or a letter of invitation for presentation for your visa.

Global Leadership Training Center is the training arm of Master's Touch Ministries Global, Inc. Believers who have a passion for missions and desire to further the reach of their ministry efforts are encouraged to take advantage of this dynamic *experiential* apprentice training program. The apprentice program includes student trips, hands-on learning in building and maintaining effective missions outreach, and effective use of technology to support missions. The core curriculum focuses on international community development and equips leaders to empower nations through developing a physical infrastructure as well as spiritual impartation. **Global Leadership Training Center** is designed for those serious about the nations and the desire to be equipped as a 21st Century leaders.

The necessary step-by-step procedures involved in attending the Global Leadership Training Center (GLTC).

1. GLTC will process your application as soon as all documents are completed and returned to our office. Submit a photocopy of your passport with your application.
2. Two recommendations are required. Recommendation Forms are provided in this packet. *First*, have your pastor complete the Pastor's Recommendation. *Second*, have colleague with whom you have worked (not a relative) complete the Colleague's Recommendation. Both recommendations must be returned immediately to GLTC.
3. A physical examination within the last six (6) months is required. Have a standard medical check-up and return a Statement or Certificate of Health or Medical Certificate from your doctor's office. *We must be informed of any medical conditions you may have.*
4. Upon review of your application, we will send you an official notification of admissions status (letter of invitation/sponsorship for international apprentices) along with a packet of further instructions, if necessary. An official letter of invitation will be forwarded to assist you in obtaining a visa. Forward a copy of your visa immediately upon securing the visa.
5. Prepare for the most intense training you have ever experienced! You will participate in every aspect of GLTC including world missions seminar, hands-on training, evangelistic outreach, and spiritual impartation! Apprenticeship training provides opportunities to *serve* and to *lead* in various aspects of establishing, operating, and maintaining a training center and global ministry.
6. Due to insurance coverage and apprenticeship program activities, children, spouses or other family are not permitted to live with the apprentice in dormitories. Dormitories are gender-specific.
7. Packing. Pack two suitcases and one carrying bag only of clothing and personal items you will need. Winston-Salem is located in the temperate climate zone, with temperatures ranging from very cold in the winter to very hot and humid in the summer.
8. *You are responsible for any "special needs" you may have such as toiletries, special linens, blankets, etc.* Men's and Women's Dormitories are equipped with cooking pots and dishes for use while on campus. Tuition covers housing, food, local transportation, and field trips, unless otherwise specified.

Apprentices who choose to live *off-site* are responsible for their own housing, food, transportation, personal expenses, medical care, and as well as program fees.

Apprentices living on-site are responsible for their medical care and personal expenses. Living on-site allows apprentices to deepen their learning and network with other apprentices and with visiting lecturers.

9. We advise that you email or fax copies of your application and forward via airmail a hardcopy.
